## Alpine Scout Camp Alpine, New Jersey February 17-19, 2010

Registration begins at 8:00 A.M. on Wednesday. Sessions begin at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday and close at 11:30 A.M. on Friday. You should make arrangements to arrive by the registration time. You may wish to arrive Tuesday evening, however if you can not arrive before 12:00 A.M., please plan to stay at a nearby motel and finish your travel Wednesday morning. You will be sleeping inside on cots or beds. Accommodations range from four or more in a room/dormitory.

Prior to the school, we strongly encourage you to review the Cub Scout Leader Fast Start Video Tapes and complete Youth Protection Training. Attendance at the Cub Scout Leader Basic Training will also be helpful.

In addition to the items you may wish to bring to share, we suggest you bring for your use during the course the previous year's or upcoming year's promotional flyer, daily program schedules, budget, and staff manual. A trading post of NCS items and some program materials will be available at the school. A campfire will be conducted in which your den/section will be asked to participate.

Please remember you will be walking to and from dining halls, sleeping areas and classrooms so bring appropriate outdoor wear for the time of year you are attending camp school.

The school will be using the Investigating the Past/Discovering the Future theme, and we encourage you to bring costumes, materials, skits, ideas, etc. to support this theme. Sharing of materials/ideas from other themes will also be appreciated.

Also enclosed is an information sheet, map of camp with directions and a health form. Emergency phone number is **201-768-1910**.

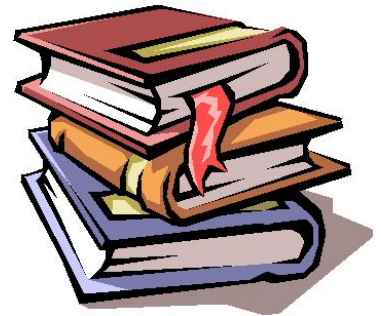
