

TRAVEL ACCOMMODATIONS TO ADIRONDACK REGION

BY BUS

Greyhound Lines, Inc. 518-434-8095 (Albany Terminal) Closest they stop is Glens Falls or Plattsburgh.

Champ Express 518-523-4431 – Offers service within Essex County and between Lake Placid and Plattsburgh, connecting with Greyhound busses there.

Adirondack Trailways 1-800-225-6815 – Leave Manhattan as early as 10:00 AM from the Port Authority Bus Terminal, from even numbered gates 28-36 for Lake George, Saranac Lake, Keene Valley and many other towns. The weekend special also operates on this route as far as Saranac Lake (Saranac Lake Hotel) where it splits off to end in Tupper Lake at 12:55 AM.

BY TRAIN

Amtrak 212-582-6875 (Penn Station) – Makes several stops in the Adirondacks.

BY PLANE

Adirondack Airport at Lake Clear 518-891-2290 – about 15 minutes from Saranac Lake and 30 minutes from Lake Placid. Served only by US Airways - 19 seat Beachcraft plane.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP MASSAWEPIE

FROM SYRACUSE: I-81 North to Exit 48/Route 342 (to avoid Watertown). Follow 342 east to Route 3; east on 3 to 3A; and east back to Route 3. Turn left and follow Route 3 to the reservation, 16 miles past Cranberry Lake. Turn Right off Route 3 at our big sign and go about ½ mile. Turn left at 4-way intersection and park in large lot, you will have drove by the Trek Lodge on the left.

FROM ALBANY I-87 North to Warrensburg (about 55 miles, just north of Lake George). U.S. Route 9 north to NY Route 28 to Blue Mountain Lake (about 45 miles). NY Route 30 north to Tupper Lake (about 33 miles). Take Route 3 West. Massawepie Scout Camps will be on the left after a sign for Gale.

FROM UTICA: NY route 12 north to Alder Creek (about 25 miles). NY Route 28 north to Blue Mountain Lake (about 64 miles) follow above directions from Blue Mountain Lake.

AT MASSAWEPIE Enter from Route 3 and pass a private home, warehouse, shop area – about 0.5 miles from Route 3 is a 4-way intersection. Follow the main dirt road to the left. Park in the large lot. You will have passed the Reservation Office on your left, go there to check in.

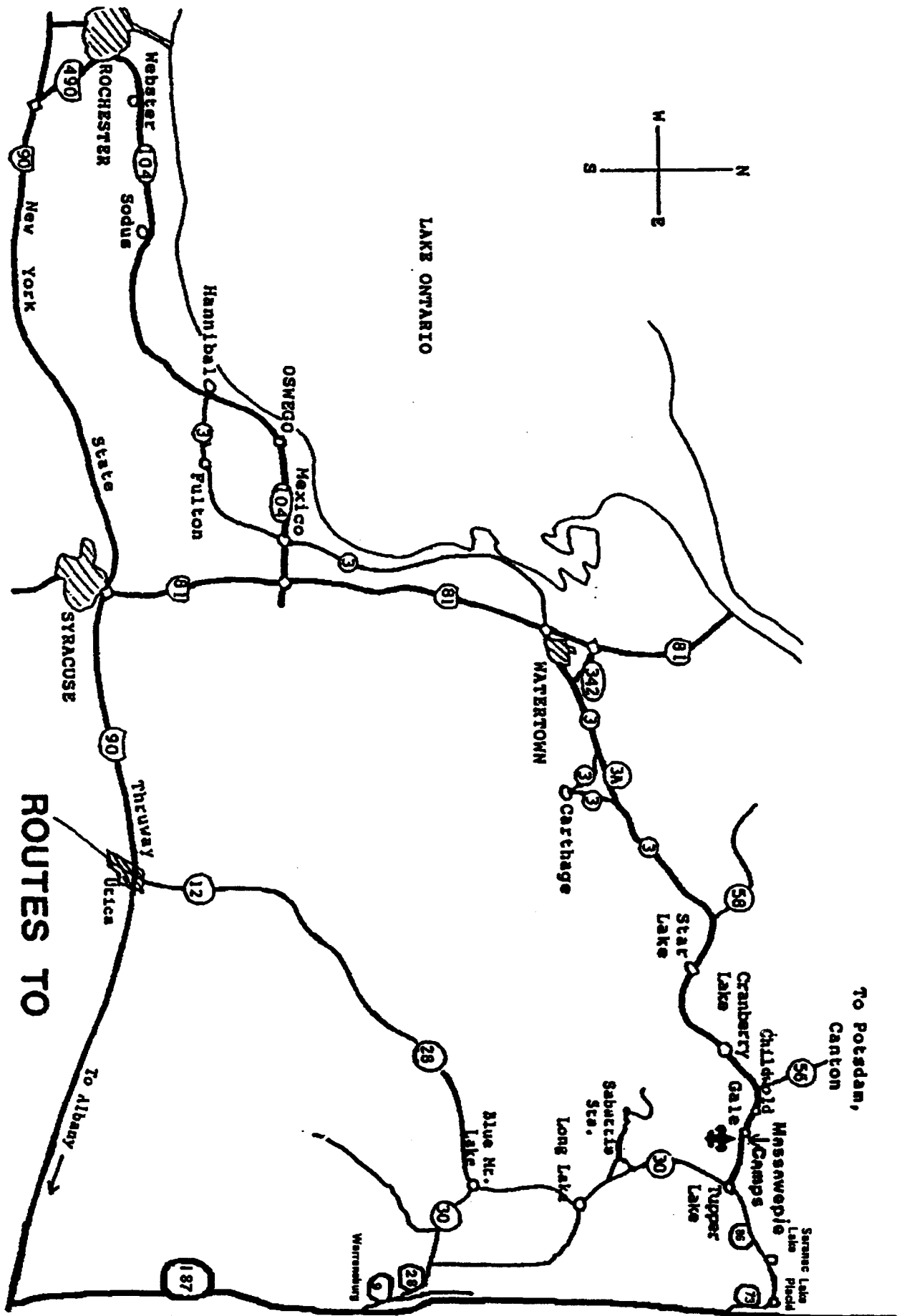
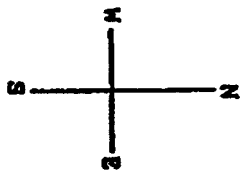
